You may choose only the items you desire. **However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead.** If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Prior to drafting any contract for goods or services, the responsible party or the decedent's survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements is entitled to receive a copy of any preneed agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in full or in part, by or on behalf of the decedent.

## SERVICES, FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT

### 1. Basic Professional Services of Funeral Director and Staff (Required) .....\$ 595.

This is a basic fee that we charge every family for our professional expertise in assisting them with their preferences. It includes a portion of our overhead, which includes taxes, licenses, utilities and business expenses required to serve the public. Our charge includes, but is not limited to consultation with the family, administrative and clerical services, preparations of the death certificate for certification by the attending physician or coroner, local procurement of death certificate, preparation of required permits, filing the death certificate with appropriate agencies, and when necessary, notification to clergy, cemetery, crematory or common carrier. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. *(This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations.)*

### 2. Preparation of Remains

*Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral or witness with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as a direct cremation.*

- A) On site Refrigeration of unembalmed remains (first 5 days, or portion thereof) ..... \$ 250.  
*California Code of Regulations, Section 1223 C: An unembalmed body must be refrigerated if held longer than 24 hours*  
Additional refrigeration (each day, beyond 2 days) ..... Additional 50.
- B) Professional Embalming ..... 425.
- C) Embalming of autopsied remains (or other cases requiring special care) ..... Additional 300.
- D) Sanitary care (Optional) ..... 100.
- E) Dressing and casketing of unembalmed remains ..... 100.
- F) Hairstyling ..... 50.
- G) Pacemaker Removal and Disposal (by a license embalmer) ..... 50.

### 3. Use of Facilities and Staff for Viewing or Services

- A) Identification of Decease Prior to Cremation (one person, one minute)..... Included.
- B) Use of Facilities and Staff for Memorial Service ..... \$ 490.
- C) Use of Facilities and Staff for Society Gathering, No Service (2 hours, \$500 refundable deposit required) ..... 390.
- D) Use of Facilities and Staff for Graveside Memorial Service ..... 290.
- E) Additional use of Facility (per hour) ..... 150.
- F) Use of Facilities and Staff for I.D. Viewing  
(Scheduled I.D. Viewing – unembalmed, up to 6 family members, up to 30 minutes) ..... 200.
- G) Use of Additional Staff need for Services or Gathering (per staff) ..... 90.
- H) Coordination of a Memorial Service without the presence of a Funeral Director ..... 190.
- I) Evening Service Charge (any service or viewing being held after 5:00 PM, any location) ..... Additional 500.
- J) Weekend / Holiday Service or Viewing ..... Additional 500.

### 4. Automotive Equipment \*

- A) Local Removal or Transfer of Deceased to Crematory (up to 45 miles from our location)..... \$ 295.
- B) Additional Removal Accommodations (Residential, Second Attendant, or Other Special Circumstances)..... Additional 200.
- C) Transfer of Decease from Crematory to Mortuary or Autopsy Location, Return to Crematory (Local)..... 195.
- D) Utility Vehicle (For procurement of Local, State and Foreign documents, Delivery of Cremated Remains or Flower Transportation)..... 195.
- E) Hearse / Funeral Service Vehicle and Driver ..... 395.

### 5. Cremation Fee

- A) Standard Cremation (up to 299 lbs.) ..... \$250.
- B) Child Cremation (1 – 12 years old) ..... 125.
- C) Infant Cremation (less than 1 year.) ..... 75.
- D) Fetal Cremation (under 20 weeks gestation) ..... 50.
- E) Oversize Cremation Surcharge (decease plus container) ..... Additional \$1.75 per lbs. over 300 lbs.
- F) Casketed Cremation (Hard Wood Cremation Casket, No Metal) ..... Additional 75.
- G) Witness Cremation Insertion (Scheduled Witness, 15 minutes) ..... Starting at 200.
- H) Witness Cremation (Full Cremation Process) ..... 490.
- I) Priority / Rush Cremation (Completed within 2 days after receipt of County Permit Issues) ..... 250.
- J) Standard Shipping of Cremated Remains within U.S. .... Starting at 95.
- K) Scattering Cremated Remains at Sea (Un-witnessed) ..... Starting at 195.

### 6. Adult Casket & Alternative Container Selection Range

- A) Adult Casket Range..... \$ 595. To \$1,895.
- B) Alternative Container Range ..... \$ 55. To \$ 395.
